Some of our Company Section prepared a worship service that focused on the issues involved. Approx 35 people attended made up of Boys and Church members in this service.

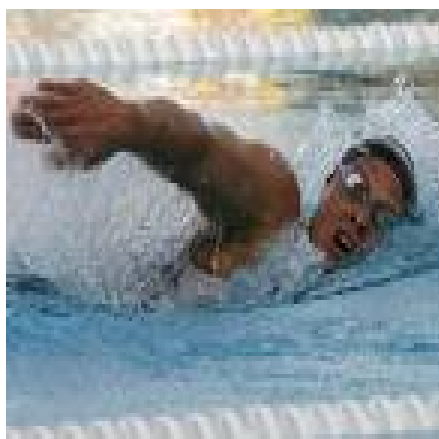
